Parkview

Gibraltar will have the design development packet to Skillman by Friday. Cost estimates will be available by November 18, 2016. This will include the cost to build a larger soccer field and extend the walking path. Gibraltar will design two or three 10 x 15 rooms set up as neutral space that can be used from year to year based on need. Jim reported there are two nurses' offices at Parkview with one serving as the district office and one as the student clinic. Two nurses' offices were not planned in the renovation. Julie said these two offices can be combined.

Construction Updates

All windows are on site and one window has been installed at the new elementary school. Room additions are ready to be enclosed at Cooks and Memorial. Steel is on site at VHS for the STEM additions in the back. Jim reported they have plans to meet with the Family & Consumer Science Dept. at VHS in the next few weeks.

Hallway Sinks

Plumbing code requires a certain number of sinks based on the number of students. Gibraltar will look at space in Parkview, Thomas Jefferson and Northview and determine how many sinks are required. Some sinks could be in the hall and some inside the washroom. All the sinks will be in the hallway at the new elementary school.
