### **VHS**

The final documents to check for quality control are ready for review before Gibraltar releases the specs to Skillman. Scott reported that the Auditorium will be available for opening day in August 2016. It will be closed for renovations in the fall.

### **New Elementary School**

Everything is on schedule, they are 50% done with the foundation and structural steel will be installed and finished by the end of July 2016. Scott and Don Torrenge will meet on 5/11 at the site on Highway 2 to get a visual for the construction of the blister lanes. Dr. Frataccia reported that a farmer requested to farm the land on the other side of the creek adjacent to the 10 acre parcel that was purchased. Scott reported that they have plans to level the ground but not until next spring, so this would be the last year that he could farm it.

### **Memorial /Cooks Elementary Gym Additions**

Work will begin next week on the gymnasium additions. Scott reported that the classroom renovations will be finished by September, but the office and cafeteria will not be complete until December 2017.

### **Summer Work 2016 – Outside Referenda**

Todd reported that he will be getting bids for the drainage work at Ben Franklin Middle School this month.

Color samples will be sent for approval for the track resurfacing projects at Ben Franklin and Thomas Jefferson Middle Schools. A discussion was held about the damage that football cleats cause when players walk across the track to access the football field. Todd will arrange for a runner to be placed across the track to protect it from cleats.
