### **VHS**

On June 23, a total of 35 bids were received for 10 Bid Categories for the VHS Renovations project. Tower Contracting, LLC submitted a bid for *Bid Category No. 1 – General Trades*, but they submitted a letter requesting withdrawal of their bid. Skillman recommends that we accept their request and reject this bid. Skillman conducted pre-award conferences and is prepared to recommend award contracts at the Board meeting today.

After Skillman reviewed *Bid Category No. 1 – Roofing Bids* it was determined there were disparities in the scope of work and they recommend rejecting all the bids received and rebidding this scope. Skillman will recommend this course of action at the Board meeting today.

### **Construction Progress**

#### **New Elementary School**

Structural details, electrical, plumbing and masonry work is progressing at the new school.

#### **Cooks Corners and Memorial**

Access roads have been constructed for the Gym Box Projects at Cooks Corners and Memorial and equipment is being mobilized for work to begin next week. Masonry has been selected for the gym boxes.

### **Summer Work**

Track re-surfacing at Thomas Jefferson Middle School will begin after the July 4<sup>th</sup> event on the property.

The floor in the field house at TJM will be started in mid-July.

The Gym Pit at VHS will be cut and excavated next week.

### **Beauty Creek Dam Project**

Scott is prepared to make a recommendation to the Board for Lawson-Fisher Associates to engineer/design (\$54,900), Earth Exploration to perform geotechnical investigation/borings (\$17,900), and Torrenga Engineering to perform the topographic survey of the area (\$7,500). Lawson-Fisher Associates is the firm who designed the existing dam.
