

VHS Mentor facilitator

LEAD Mentor Program Facilitators will:

- Act as logistical liaison between the VHS Mentor Program/LEAD System and its coordinators and the middle school. This entails communicating and clearing the way for mentor visits to the middle school, scheduling in-house venues and making sure they are ready to go each month, matching homerooms with mentor teams, copying handouts and preparing monthly supplies, and other in-house logistical needs as needed to maintain high-quality monthly mentor visits with 6th and 7th graders.
- Work closely with the Student Leadership/Climate Coordinator, Director of Culture and Student Services, and the middle school LEAD Sponsors.
- Attend the summer mentor training/ Sources of Strength training at Aberdeen.
- Attend monthly LEAD mentor trainings from September – April (8 meetings) one Sunday per month from 4-6 p.m.(subject to change)
- Supervise and assist their mentor team of 14-16 mentors during each mentoring visit to the middle schools during the school day; subs will be provided by VCS. (October – April)
- Support mentors' efforts with Sources of Strength and use their own newly acquired SOS skills learned at training with VHS students.
- Act as Trusted Adults at VHS and assist with SOS campaigns.
